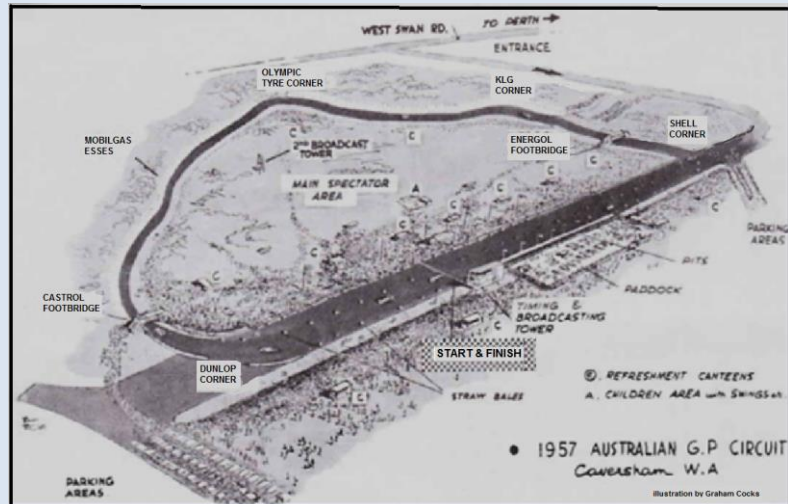
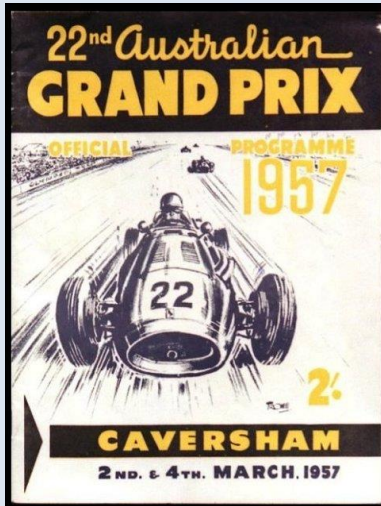


COMBINED FRENCH CAR CLUBS DRIVE DAY

SATURDAY 05th OCTOBER 2019

Take a drive to the historic Caversham Race circuit which was used for the Australian Grand prix in 1957 and 1962.

Have a look at the history and memorabilia on display at the VSCCWA Caversham clubrooms and then take a drive around the historic race track.



The plan is for all participants to meet up at the Wireless Hill Reserve in Applecross from 09.30am on Saturday 05th October 2019 to show and shine their French Cars, and to have a chat. *(Participants, please BYO morning beverages)*

At 10.30am the cars will then leave in convoy from Wireless hill and proceed to the VSCCWA clubrooms in Caversham for lunch. *(BBQ facilities are available)*

The cars will travel East along Canning Hwy to the Freeway, turn Left to travel North along the Freeway and then turn Right to travel East on Reid Hwy. Cars will then turn Left into West Swan Rd. *(Maybe pick up some lunch and / or munchies along the way)*

Participants will then turn Left into Harrow Rd and proceed to the VSCCWA clubroom gate which is marked by a drum and signage.

Once at the VSCCWA clubrooms participants are invited to leave their vehicles, have lunch, inspect the facilities, and take in some of the history and memorabilia on display.

Participants will then be invited to take a guided tour / drive of the historic Caversham Race circuit before heading home.
